David and America J. Williams

Nearly all the information on this couple comes from their record in the 1880 United States census.

David Williams was born about 1827 in Indiana. His parents names are unknown but both were born in Tennessee. David was a farmer.

His wife, America, whose maiden name is unknown, was also born in Indiana, in about 1837. She gave her father's birthplace as Virginia and her mother's as Kentucky.

There was only one child of David and America listed in the 1880 census -- Thomas H. Williams, born in 1857 -- but a niece and a nephew were also listed as part of the household.

Thomas H. Williams was born December 12, 1857 in Green Township, Morgan County, Indiana to David and America Williams. He is their only known child and became a farmer.

Sarah Isabelle Guthridge was the fifth of twelve children of Lemuel Aaron Guthridge and Elizabeth J. Teeters. She was born August 14, 1860, also in Green Township.

The couple married in Morgan County on June 2, 1881. They had seven children, all presumably born in Morgan County:

- Mary A. Williams
- Margaret F. Williams, born in 1889
- Bessie Lucille Williams, born in 1891
- Henry Lemuel Williams, born in 1896
- Harry Gordon Williams

Thomas died in Green Township on December 27, 1920.

Sarah died in Indianapolis, Indiana on June 21, 1939 at age 78.

Both are buried in Centennial Cemetery in Morgan County, Indiana.
